



Dear UW Medical Foundation Employee,

Beginning in 2014, the federal Affordable Care Act (ACA) requires most everyone to obtain health insurance for themselves and their dependents. The Health Insurance Marketplace (also known as the Exchange) is an option for people to obtain health insurance.

As your employer, UW Medical Foundation (UWMF) is required to provide all employees with a Notice of the availability of the Health Insurance Marketplace. The Notice also includes required information regarding health insurance coverage available through your employment at UWMF.

**If you have or will have health insurance coverage through your UWMF employment, you do not need to enroll through the Marketplace or take any action,** unless you choose to do so. You may want to review the plans available through the Marketplace to see if they may better suit your needs.
